  - B. A Godly Teacher is Challenged
    - 1. Pray through the Text
    - 2. Don't Predetermine Your Conclusions
    - 3. Don't Avoid Uncomfortable Truths
    - 4. Don't Worry about Needing All the Answers
    - 5. Pull Weeds, but Don't Forget to Water the Lawn
