TO ALL PARENTS OF CHILDREN PARTICIPATING IN VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL AT FIRST AMERICAN
LUTHERAN AND FRIEDENS REFORMED.

In the past, we have had some discipline problems, which led to class disruptions. In order to maintain discipline and respect for the pastors, teachers, helpers, and in the classrooms, the Vacation Bible School Committee has adopted the following policy:

If the teacher has given a warning to the student for misbehavior, and that behavior continues to disrupt the class, then you or someone that is able to pick them up will be called to come and take your child home for that day. They will not be allowed to stay in the classroom, instead, they will be waiting in the pastor's office until you come and pick them up.

They are allowed to come back the next day, but if the problem of misbehavior still persists, then you will be called to come and pick up your child and he/she will not be allowed to attend the rest of the week of Vacation Bible School.

This kind of behavior is disruptive and disrespectful for those wanting to enjoy Vacation Bible School.

In order for us to make this week of VBS a successful and enjoyable experience for all of our students, we have to maintain a degree of respect from our students of their actions in the classroom and in the church. And if they are not going to respect it, then we will need to take the above steps to ensure that.

We want our VBS to be an enjoyable and fun learning experience for all of our students and teachers/helpers.

Please do not bring your child(ren) more than 10 minutes before VBS begins. Each morning when students arrive, please have students go directly to the church sanctuary. Reminder: no running in any part of the church at any time!

Please take time to discuss these expectations with your child(ren).
